#### **8 REPORTS FROM VARIOUS MEETINGS**

BC and Mrs Anderson attended a UK Coal meeting on 8 June 2010 and they were told that the bypass is not to be surfaced dressed but that a new surface is to be placed on top of the existing surface. Signs will then be erected at the staggered junction.

BC and Mr Anderson attended a meeting at Darrington Quarries on the 8 June 2010 and were told that Darrington East is now dry and they propose to fill the corner in.

WRG were at the meeting and their representatives told the meeting that they are to apply for planning permission to erect between 5-7 wind turbines on their land. As yet no planning application has been received by Selby District Council. A scoping plan is to be applied for to erect a test mast.

The meeting was then suspended by the chair to let the public discuss this proposed application.

The meeting was re-opened at 8.00pm.
