10 PLAYGROUND UPDATE

A plan of the playground from Sutcliffes has been received.

Sutcliffes quoted for 26 square metres of safety surfacing instead of 260. Community Spaces have said that they will help with the extra cost and Sutcliffes have said they will help as well.

11 PLANNING APPLICATION - MANOR FARM BUNGALOW TO TRIM  
THE LIME TREE AND T2 AND TO FELL THE ACER TI.

BC opened this item to the public.

The previous owner had applied for planning application to build two bungalows. He had put a preservation order on the acer. A report was received from the owners and a felling company he had employed and the report said that the acer tree was dangerous.

OBSERVATIONS - Ask SDC if they would do a survey or appoint an independent tree surgeon to inspect the acer. Also would they hold back on any decision until the full foliage is on the tree.

The previous owner had a tree preservation order put on the acer tree in order to satisfy any objections that the building of a bungalow would damage the tree. TPO order no. 9/2003.

The parish council suggest that SDC look at the planning application given for building on this site as planning application had been granted providing the tree was left on site.

#### 14 ARRIVA BUS SERVICE

#### 15 INSURANCE RENEWAL

#### 16 HIGHWAY UPDATE

New signs have been ordered, and the re surfacing will be done when the weather picks up.

The drains from the highway to the ditch are hardly working and there is only a trickle of water coming through.

#### 17 SERVICING OF THE MOWER AND RUNNING COSTS

CW has looked at the mower manual and he thinks that it needs a full service. He also thinks that Ripon Farm be asked to install the mulching kit at the same time. LW is to book the mower and strimmer in for a full service.

It was decided to set aside £200 for running costs for the mower and strimmer, a cheque for £100 was given to LW to cover the first half of the running costs.
